Big Idea: Our families are not the enemy. We must battle against the devil, our culture and our flesh for the future of our families.

"Do not give the devil a foothold." Ephesians 4:27 (NIV) Remember Verse

2. Trust God's Design ➤ In Marriage

"For a husband is the **head** of his wife as Christ is the head of the church. He is the Savior of his body, the church. As the church submits to Christ, so you wives should submit to your husbands in everything. For husbands, this means **love** your wives, just as Christ loved the church. He gave up his life for her."

Ephesians 5:23-25 (NLT2)

"In the same way, you wives must **accept the authority** of your husbands. Then, even if some refuse to obey the Good News, your **godly lives** will speak to them without any words. They will be won over by observing your **pure** and **reverent** lives." **1 Peter 3:1-2 (NLT2)**

> In the Church

"Now these are the **gifts** Christ gave to the church: the apostles, the prophets, the evangelists, and the pastors and teachers. Their responsibility is to **equip** God's people **to do** His work and build up the church, the body of Christ."

Ephesians 4:11-12 (NLT2)

> In Employment

"Slaves, obey your earthly masters with deep respect and fear. Serve them sincerely as you would serve Christ. Try to please them all the time, not just when they are watching you. As slaves of Christ, do the will of God with all your heart. Work with enthusiasm, as though you were working for the Lord rather than for people.

Remember that the Lord will reward each one of us for the good we do, whether we are slaves or free. **Masters**, treat your slaves in the same way. Don't threaten them; remember, you both have the **same Master** in heaven, and he has no favorites." **Ephesians 6:5-9 (NLT2)**

"Everyone must submit himself to the governing authorities, for there is no authority except that which **God has established**. The authorities that exist have been established by God." **Romans 13:1 (NIV)**

	3. Make Our Family An Example Of "As the Scriptures say, "A man leaves his father and mother and is joined to his wife and the two are united into one." This is a great mystery, but it is an illustration of the way Christ and the church are one. So again I say, each man must love his wife as he loves himself, and the wife must respect her husband." Ephesians 5:31-33 (NLT2)

	➤ Give thanks and pray for them "I have not stopped thanking God for you. I pray for you constantly, asking God, the glorious Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, to give you spiritual wisdom and insight so that you might grow in your knowledge of God." Ephesians 1:16-17 (NLT2)

I Will Protect My Family By Choosing To:

1. Cooperate Voluntarily Out Of Love And Respect For Christ

Commentary: 5:21, 22 Submitting to another person is an often misunderstood concept. It does not mean becoming a doormat. Christ—at whose name "every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth" (Philippians 2:10)—submitted his will to the Father, and we honor Christ by following his example. When we submit to God, we become more willing to obey his command to submit to others, that is, to subordinate our rights to theirs. In a marriage relationship, both husband and wife are called to submit. For the wife, this means willingly following her husband's leadership in Christ. For the husband, it means putting aside his own interests in order to care for his wife. Life Application Study Bible.

2. Trust God's Design Has An Eternal Purpose

Commentary: <u>5:22-24</u>. According to the Bible, the man is the spiritual head of the family, and his wife should acknowledge his leadership. But real spiritual leadership involves loving service (a form of dying). Just as Christ served the disciples, even to the point of washing their feet, so the husband is to serve his wife. A wise and Christ-honoring husband will not take advantage of his leadership role, and a wise and Christ-honoring wife will not try to undermine her husband's leadership. Either approach causes disunity and friction in marriage. Life Application Study Bible.
