	"Once you were dead because of your disobedience and your many sins. You used
	to live in sin, just like the rest of the world, obeying the devil—the commander of the
	powers in the unseen world. He is the spirit at work in the hearts of those who refuse
	to obey God. All of us used to live that way, following the passionate desires and
	inclinations of our sinful nature. By our very nature we were subject to God's anger,
	just like everyone else. But God is so rich in mercy, and He loved us so much, that
	even though we were dead because of our sins, He gave us life when He raised
	Christ from the dead. (It is only by God's grace that you have been saved!)"

"For God was in Christ, reconciling the world to Himself, **no longer counting people's sins against them.** And He gave us this wonderful message of reconciliation. So we are Christ's ambassadors; God is making his appeal through us. We speak for Christ when we plead, "Come back to God!"

2. Develop A Heart For The Lost Read Romans 1:14-15 How strong is my sense of obligation to share Jesus with others? Read Romans 1:16-17 Why should I be unashamed to share Jesus? What are we saved from? Pause and pray this prayer: "Lord, give me a heart for those who don't know You." If we prayed this pray each day for the next week, would that increase our sense of obligation? 3. Pray For Opportunities To Share My Faith Read Ephesians 6:19-20 What was Paul's circumstances? What are my circumstances? Am I willing to pray this prayer for myself? Colossians 4:3-4 What is Paul's prayer? If I pray for God to open doors for me to share Jesus, will He? 4. Actively Share My Hope In Jesus Read Philemon 1:6 How active am I in sharing my faith with my family? Co-workers? Friends? Read Romans 10:9-14 In verse 14, how does Paul make his point that we need to tell others?

Is there someone God is placing on your heart to invite to church? Who?
