"**Stand firm** then, with the belt of **truth** buckled around your waist, with the breastplate of **righteousness** in place, and with your feet fitted with the readiness that comes from the **gospel** of peace. In addition to all this, take up the shield of **faith**, with which you can extinguish all the flaming arrows of the evil one. Take the helmet of **salvation** and the sword of the Spirit, which is the **Word of God.**"

To Stand Firm With The Word Of God I Must:

1. Study The Bible _____

"For I have not hesitated to proclaim to you the **whole will** of God. **Keep watch** over yourselves and all the flock of which the Holy Spirit has made you **overseers**. Be **shepherds** of the church of God, which He bought with His own blood. I know that after I leave, savage **wolves** will come in among you and will not spare the flock. Even from your **own number** men will arise and **distort the truth** in order to **draw away disciples after them**. So be on your guard! Remember that for three years I never stopped **warning** each of you night and day with tears." **Acts 20:27-31 (NIV)**

"Do your best to present yourself to God as one **approved**, a workman who does not need to be ashamed and who **correctly handles the word of truth**. Avoid **godless chatter**, because those who indulge in it will become more and more ungodly. Their teaching will spread like gangrene. Among them are Hymenaeus and Philetus, who have **wandered away from the truth**. They say that the resurrection has already taken place, and they **destroy** the faith of some. Nevertheless, God's solid foundation stands firm, sealed with this inscription: "The Lord **knows** those who are His," and, "Everyone who **confesses** the name of the Lord must **turn away** from wickedness." **2 Timothy 2:15-19 (NIV)**

“For the time will come when men will not put up with **sound doctrine**. Instead, to suit their own desires, they will gather around them a great number of teachers to say what their itching ears **want to hear**. They will turn their ears away from the **truth** and turn aside to **myths**.” **2 Timothy 4:3-4 (NIV)**

3. Apply God's Word _____

“The farmer sows the word. Some people are like seed along the **path**, where the word is sown. As soon as they hear it, Satan comes and **takes away** the word that was sown in them. Others, like seed sown on **rocky places**, hear the word and at once receive it with **joy**. But since they have **no root**, they last only a short time. When **trouble or persecution** comes because of the word, they quickly fall away. Still others, like seed sown among **thorns**, hear the word; but the **worries** of this life, the **deceitfulness of wealth** and the **desires** for other things come in and choke the word, making it **unfruitful**. Others, like seed sown on **good soil**, hear the word, **accept it**, and produce a crop--thirty, sixty or even a hundred times what was sown.” **Mark 4:14-20 (NIV)**

“Therefore everyone who hears these words of mine and puts them into **practice** is like a wise man who built his house on the rock. The rain came down, the streams rose, and the winds blew and beat against that house; yet it did not fall, because it had its **foundation** on the rock. But everyone who hears these words of mine and **does not put them into practice** is like a foolish man who built his house on sand. The rain came down, the streams rose, and the winds blew and beat against that house, and it fell with a **great crash**.” **Matthew 7:24-27 (NIV)**
