# To Find My Way Back Home And Experience God's Mercy:

### 1. I Must Realize God Will Allow Me To

Although God wants me to be close - God doesn't force me to be close. To illustrate the point further, Jesus told them this story: "A man had two sons. The younger son told his father, 'I want my share of your estate now before you die.' So his father agreed to divide his wealth between his sons. "A few days later this younger son packed all his belongings and moved to a distant land, and there he **wasted** all his money in **wild living**. **Luke 15:11-13 (NLT2)**

#### 2. I Must Turn Away \_

About the time his money ran out, a great famine swept over the land, and he began to starve. He persuaded a local farmer to hire him, and the man sent him into his fields to feed the pigs. The young man became so hungry that even the pods he was feeding the pigs looked good to him. But no one gave him anything. "When he finally **came to his senses**, he said to himself, 'At home even the hired servants have food enough to spare, and here I am dying of hunger! **Luke 15:14-17 (NLT2)** 

I will go home to my father and say, "Father, I have sinned against both heaven and you, and I am no longer worthy of being called your son. Please take me on as a hired servant." Luke 15:18-19 (NLT2)

"Now **repent** of your sins and turn to God, so that your sins may be wiped away. Then **times of refreshment** will come from the presence of the Lord, and He will again send you Jesus, your appointed Messiah." **Acts 3:19-20 (NLT2)**

Big Idea: To Value God's Mercy, I Must Understand The Cost Of The Cross

### Open your group with a prayer.

#### Icebreaker:

How old were you when you left home? Where did you go? What did you do?

#### Read and discuss Life Application Study Bible Commentary:

Jesus Tells the Parable of the Lost Son / <u>15:11-32</u> The previous two parables—the one of lost sheep and the lost coin—build up to the climax, the parable of the lost son, a parable that is unique to Luke. Through the parable of the lost son, Jesus presents a vivid illustration of God and his mercy for repentant sinners. <u>15:11-12</u> Jesus continued with another parable to illustrate the point further that God rejoices when lost sinners repent and find forgiveness. A man had two sons, the younger of whom wanted his share of his father's estate (inheritance). This would have been one-third of the total estate, with the older son receiving two-thirds, a double portion of the other as prescribed by the law (<u>Deuteronomy 21:17</u>). In most cases, the son would have received this at his father's death, although fathers sometimes chose to divide up their inheritance early and retire from managing their estates. What is unusual is that the younger son initiated the division of the estate. This showed arrogant disregard for his father's authority as head of the family.
