Big Idea: To Value God's Mercy, I Must Understand The Cost Of The Cross

"You know what I was like when I followed the Jewish religion—how I violently persecuted God's church. I did my best to destroy it." Galatians 1:13 (NLT2)

God Can Use Me When: 1. I Remember It's All Because "Therefore, since God in His mercy has given us this new way, we never give up." 2 Corinthians 4:1 (NLT2)
"I thank Christ Jesus our Lord, who has given me strength to do His work . He considered me trustworthy and appointed me to serve him, even though I used to blaspheme the name of Christ. In my insolence, I persecuted His people. But God had mercy on me because I did it in ignorance and unbelief. Oh, how generous and gracious our Lord was! He filled me with the faith and love that come from Christ Jesus." 1 Timothy 1:12-14 (NLT2)
"This is a trustworthy saying, and everyone should accept it: "Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners"—and I am the worst of them all. But God had mercy on me so that Christ Jesus could use me as a prime example of his great patience with even the worst sinners. Then others will realize that they, too, can believe in Him and receive eternal life." 1 Timothy 1:15-16 (NLT2)

3. I Use My Pain To "We are pressed on every side by troubles, but we are not crushed. We are perplexed, but not driven to despair. We are hunted down, but never abandoned by God. We get knocked down, but we are not destroyed." 2 Corinthians 4:8-9 NLT2
"Through suffering, our bodies continue to share in the death of Jesus so that the life of Jesus may also be seen in our bodies . Yes, we live under constant danger of death because we serve Jesus, so that the life of Jesus will be evident in our dying bodies. So we live in the face of death, but this has resulted in eternal life for you." 2 Corinthians 4:10-12 (NLT2)
"All of this is for your benefit. And as God's grace reaches more and more people, there will be great thanksgiving , and God will receive more and more glory. That is why we never give up . Though our bodies are dying, our spirits are being renewed every day. For our present troubles are small and won't last very long. Yet they produce for us a glory that vastly outweighs them and will last forever!" 2 Corinthians 4:15-17 (NLT2)
"So we don't look at the troubles we can see now; rather, we fix our gaze on things that cannot be seen. For the things we see now will soon be gone, but the things we cannot see will last forever ." 2 Corinthians 4:18 (NLT2)
"God chose things the world considers foolish in order to shame those who think they are wise. And he chose things that are powerless to shame those who are powerful." 1 Corinthians 1:27 (NLT2)
