10. Communicate The Freedom To Fail

"Simon, Simon, Satan has asked to sift you as wheat.

32 But I have prayed for you, Simon, that your faith may not fail. And when you have turned back, strengthen your brothers." Luke 22:31-32 (NIV)

6. Never Abuse, Shame, Or Intimidate One Another Proverbs 11:9 & Proverbs 12:18

Discuss how words can destroy friendships. What words hurt you more than others?

Discuss how hurt people often hurt others.

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7. Never Abuse, Shame, Or Intimidate One Another Ephesians 5:3-5

Have a family discussion on appropriate boundaries for speech, touch and locations.
