Big Idea: We Need to stand united with Israel and pray for all the Jewish people.

We Stand With Israel Because:

1. God Gave An Unconditional Covenant With Israel

¹ The LORD had said to Abram, "Leave your native country, your relatives, and your father's family, and go to the land that I will show you.² I will make you into a **great nation**. I will bless you and make you famous, and you will be a blessing to others.³ I will **bless** those who bless you and **curse** those who treat you with contempt. **All the families** on earth will be blessed through you." **Genesis 12:1-3 (NLT2)**

"Therefore the Lord Himself will give you a sign: Behold, a virgin will be with child and bear a son, and she will call His name Immanuel." **Isaiah 7:14 (NASB)**

"Therefore say: 'This is what the Sovereign LORD says: I will gather you from the nations and **bring you back** from the countries where you have been scattered, and **I will give you back the land of Israel again**.' ¹⁸ "They will return to it and remove all its vile images and detestable idols. ¹⁹ I will give them an **undivided heart** and put a **new spirit in them**; I will remove from them their **heart of stone** and give them a **heart of flesh**. ²⁰ Then they will follow my decrees and be careful to keep my laws. They will be my people, and I will be their God." **Ezekiel 11:17-20 (NIV)**

2. We Use To Live Without Hope

¹¹ Don't forget that you **Gentiles** used to be **outsiders**. You were called "uncircumcised heathens" by the Jews, who were proud of their circumcision, even though it affected only their bodies and not their hearts. ¹² In those days **you were living apart from Christ**. You

were **excluded** from citizenship among the people of Israel, and you did not know the **covenant promises God** had made to them. **You lived in this world without God and without hope. Ephesians 2:11-12 (NLT2)**

3. We Have Been United With The Jewish People In Christ

¹³ But now you have been **united** with Christ Jesus. Once you were far away from God, but now you have been brought near to him **through the blood of Christ**. ¹⁴ For Christ himself has **brought peace to us**. He united **Jews and Gentiles into one people** when, **in his own body on the cross**, he broke down the **wall of hostility** that separated us. ¹⁵ He did this by ending the system of law with its commandments and regulations. He made **peace between Jews and Gentiles** by creating in himself **one new people** from the two groups. ¹⁶ **Together as one body**, Christ reconciled both groups to God by means of his death on the cross, and our hostility toward each other was put to death. ¹⁷ He brought this **Good News of peace** to you Gentiles who were far away from him, and peace to the Jews who were near. **Ephesians 2:13-17 (NLT2)**

4. Together We Are <u>Members</u> Of God's Family

¹⁸ Now all of us can come to the Father through the same **Holy Spirit** because of what **Christ has done for us**. ¹⁹ So now you **Gentiles** are no longer strangers and foreigners. You are **citizens** along with all of God's holy people. **You are members of God's family**. ²⁰ **Together**, we are his house, built on the foundation of the **apostles and the prophets**. And **the cornerstone is Christ Jesus himself**.

²¹ We are carefully joined together in him, becoming a holy temple for the Lord. ²² Through him you **Gentiles** are also being **made part of this dwelling** where **God lives by his Spirit**. **Ephesians 2:18-22 (NLT2)**
