Big Idea: A Devoted Follower Keeps Growing In Their Relationship With Jesus

What Does A Devoted Follower Of Jesus Look Like?

1. They Continue To Grow In His Word

"I am the true vine, and my Father is the gardener. 2 He cuts off every branch in me that bears no fruit, while every branch that does bear fruit he **prunes** so that it will be even more fruitful. ³ You are already clean because of the word I have spoken to you. ⁴ **Remain** in me, and I will **remain** in you. No branch can bear fruit by itself; it must **remain** Neither can you bear fruit unless you remain ⁵ "I am the vine; you are the branches. If a man **remains** in me and I in him, he will bear much fruit; apart from me you can do nothing. ⁶ If anyone does not **remain** in me, he is like a branch that is thrown away and withers; such branches are picked up, thrown into the fire and burned. ⁷ If you **remain** in me and my words **remain** in you, ask whatever you wish, and it will be given you. 8 This is to my Father's glory, that you bear much fruit, showing yourselves to be my disciples. John 15:1-8 (NIV)

"Not everyone who says to me, 'Lord, Lord,' will enter the kingdom of heaven, but only he who does the will of my Father who is in heaven. ²² Many will say to me on that day, 'Lord, Lord, did we not prophesy in your name, and in your name drive out demons and perform many miracles?' ²³ Then I will tell them plainly, 'I never knew you. Away from me, you evildoers!' ²⁴ "Therefore everyone who **hears** these words of mine and **puts them into practice** is like a wise man who built his house on the rock. ²⁵ The rain came down, the streams rose, and the winds blew and beat against that house; yet it did not fall, because it had its foundation on the rock. ²⁶ But everyone who hears these words of mine and does not put them into practice is like a foolish man who built his house on sand. ²⁷ The rain came down, the streams rose, and the winds blew and beat against that house, and it fell with a great crash." **Matthew 7:21-27 (NIV)**

2. They Continue To Grow In Love For God And Others

⁹ "As the **Father has loved me**, so have **I loved you**. Now **remain** in my love. ¹⁰ If you obey my commands, you will **remain** in my love, just as I have obeyed my Father's commands and **remain** in his love. ¹¹ I have told you this so that **my joy** may be in you and that your **joy** may be complete. ¹² My command is this: **Love each other as I have loved you**. ¹³ Greater love has no one than this, that he lay down his life for his friends. **John 15:9-13 (NIV)**

But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, ²³ gentleness and self-control. Against such things there is no law. ²⁴ Those who belong to Christ Jesus have crucified the sinful nature with its passions and desires. ²⁵ Since we live by the Spirit, let us keep in step with the Spirit. Galatians 5:22-25 (NIV)
