Big Idea: A Devoted Follower Of Jesus Trusts Him Through Suffering

The Truth About Heartache And Suffering:

- 1. It's Normal To Be Confused When God Is At Work
- ¹⁶ "In a little while you will see me no more, and then after a little while you will see me."

 Some of his disciples said to one another, "What does he mean by saying, 'In a little while you will see me no more, and then after a little while you will see me,' and 'Because I am going to the Father'?" ¹⁸ They kept asking, "What does he mean by 'a little while'? We don't understand what he is saying." ¹⁹ Jesus saw that they wanted to ask him about this, so he said to them, "Are you asking one another what I meant when I said, 'In a little while you will see me no more, and then after a little while you will see me'? ²⁰ I tell you the truth, you will weep and mourn while the world rejoices. John 16:16-20a (NIV)

Surely God is good to Israel, to those who are pure in heart. ² But as for me, my feet had **almost slipped**; I had nearly lost my foothold. ³ For I envied the arrogant when I saw the prosperity of the wicked. ⁴ They have no struggles; their bodies are healthy and strong. ⁵ They are free from the burdens common to man; they are not plagued by human ills. **Psalm 73:1-5 (NIV)**

- ¹³ Surely in vain have I kept my heart pure; in vain have I washed my hands in innocence. **Psalm 73:13 (NIV)**
- ¹⁶ When I tried to understand all this, it was **oppressive** to me ¹⁷ till I entered the sanctuary of God; then I understood their **final destiny**. **Psalm 73:16-17 (NIV)**

in my name. Ask and you will receive, and your joy will be complete. 25 "Though I

language but will tell you plainly about my Father. ²⁶ In that day you will ask in my name . I am not saying that I will ask the Father on your behalf. ²⁷ No, the Father himself
loves you because you have loved me and have believed that I came from God.
²⁸ I came from the Father and entered the world; now I am leaving the world and going
back to the Father." ²⁹ Then Jesus' disciples said, "Now you are speaking clearly and
without figures of speech. ³⁰ Now we can see that you know all things and that you do not
even need to have anyone ask you questions. This makes us believe that you came from
